

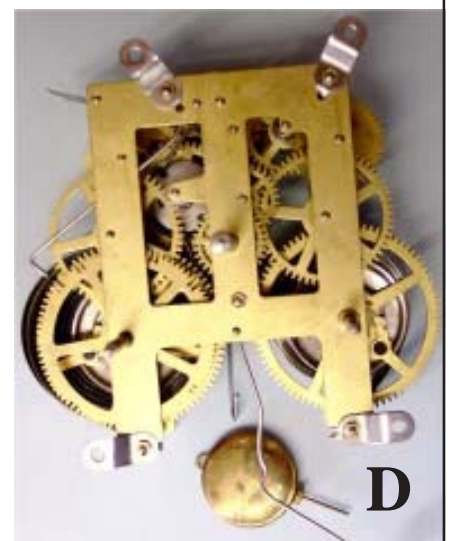
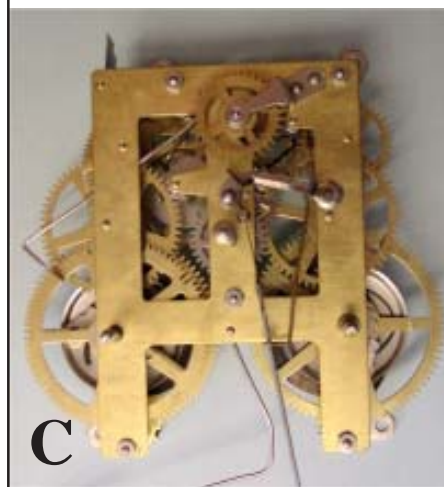
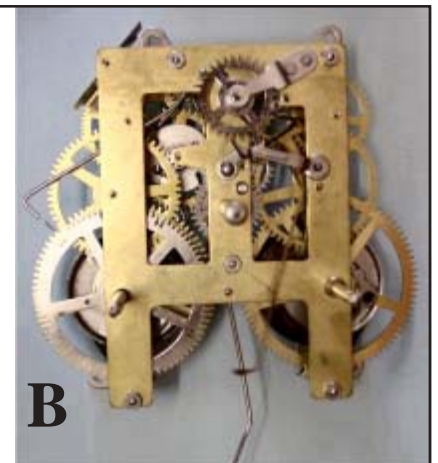
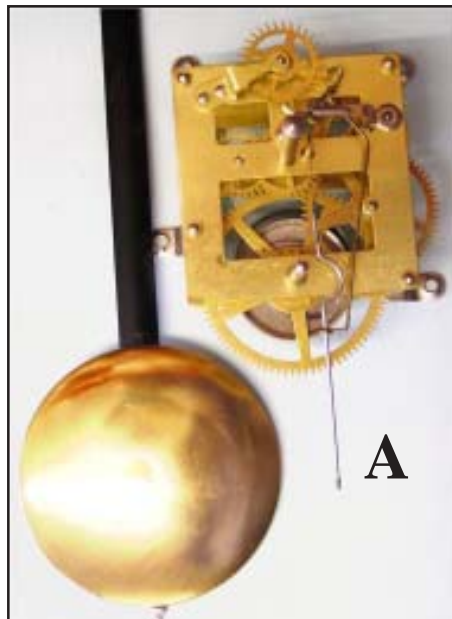
American style open spring movements

Excellent reproductions of 19th century movements. Front escapement, with long hand shaft and winding arbors for use on wallclocks.

Various are available, depending on the pendulum drop required. Length is measured from the hand shaft to the rating nut. Please note that as a typical American movement, you may need to make minor adjustments to the numerous striking wires, triggers etc when the movement has been fitted. It is often necessary to adjust the count wheel and the fly on these units as they are easily put out of adjustment in transit.

These movements are manufactured in Asia, and we have great difficulty obtaining stock of consistent specifications. We do spot checks on the stock arriving, but cannot guarantee that movements supplied will be exactly as described.

However they are excellent value and with a little adjustment they make very authentic replacements for worn-out American movements.
